The Thames Water Authority (Cotswold and Swindon) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Thames Water Authority (Cotswold and Swindon) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1978.
- 2. The byelaws made on 7th November 1963 by the Cotswold Water Board under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Thames Water Authority (Cotswold and Swindon) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976(c), remain in force until 6th November 1978, shall remain in force until 6th November 1980.
- 3. The byelaws made on 11th November 1964 by the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the borough of Swindon acting by the council of that borough under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Thames Water Authority (Cotswold and Swindon) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976, remain in force until 10th November 1978, shall remain in force until 10th November 1980.
