

1978 No. 1329**TRADE UNIONS****The Certification Officer (Amendment of Fees)
Regulations 1978**

Made - - - - *4th September 1978*
Laid before Parliament *18th September 1978*
Coming into Operation *1st November 1978*

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 8(2) of the Employment Protection Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Certification Officer (Amendment of Fees) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

Fee on application for certificate of independence

2.—In section 8 (2) of the Employment Protection Act 1975 for the words “£21” (fee on application by a trade union for a certificate of independence) there shall be substituted the words “£50”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations, which come into force on 1st November 1978, increase the fee payable to the Certification Officer by a trade union on application for a certificate of independence from £21 to £50.
