## The Yorkshire Water Authority (Huddersfield) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority (Huddersfield) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1978.

2. The byelaws made on 6th October 1965 by the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the county borough of Huddersfield acting by the council under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Yorkshire Water Authority (Huddersfield) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976(c), remain in force until 5th October 1978, shall remain in force until 5th October 1980.
