**The North West Water Authority (Manchester) (Extension of  
Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978**

*Made* - - - - *22nd September 1978*

*Coming into Operation* *1st October 1978*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the North West Water Authority (Manchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1978.

2. The byelaws made on 16th October 1967 by the lord mayor, aldermen and citizens of the city of Manchester under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the North West Water Authority (Manchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977(c), remain in force until 15th October 1978, shall remain in force until 15th October 1980.
