The Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1978

Coming into Operation 27th November 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967(a), as extended by section 6 of the Legal Advice and Assistance Act 1972(b), and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, I hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 27th November 1978.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. In paragraph 7(d) of the Schedule to the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1973(d) as amended (e) for the amounts "£125", "£80" and "£40" there shall be substituted the amounts "£200", "£120" and "£60" respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1973 by increasing the allowances for dependants in the assessment of disposable capital. The allowance for the first dependant is increased from £125 to £200, for the second from £80 to £120 and for every other dependant from £40 to £60.
