**HIGHWAYS, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Maentwrog-East of Conwy Trunk Road  
(Maenan Abbey, near Llanrwst, Diversion) Order 1978**

*Made - - - - 20th November 1978*  
*Coming into Operation 21st December 1978*

The Secretary of State for Wales makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in the Schedule to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

3. In this Order:—

“the deposited plan” means the plan numbered H/A 7/2-WO 109A marked “The Maentwrog-East of Conwy Trunk Road (Maenan Abbey, near Llanrwst, Diversion) Order 1978”, signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff, where it is open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours;

“the new trunk road” means the highway mentioned in Article 1 of this Order;

“the Trunk Road” means the Maentwrog to Betws-y-Coed to East of Conwy Trunk Road (A470).

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 21st December 1978 and may be cited as the Maentwrog-East of Conwy Trunk Road (Maenan Abbey, near Llanrwst, Diversion) Order 1978.

## SCHEDULE

### ROUTE OF THE NEW TRUNK ROAD

The route of the new trunk road is as follows:—

A route about 250 metres in length starting at a point on the Trunk Road about 276 metres south of Maenan Abbey Lodge and then going in a general southerly direction to rejoin the Trunk Road about 526 metres south of Maenan Abbey Lodge.

Unit of length: 1 metre = 1.094 yards approximately.
