**The Trunk Road (Eastern Avenue, Redbridge)  
(Prescribed Route) Order 1978**

Made - - - - 5th December 1978

Coming into Operation 11th December 1978

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b), and now vested in him(c), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Secretary of State for the Home Department, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (Eastern Avenue, Redbridge) (Prescribed Route) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 11th December 1978.

2.—(1) In this Order:—

“Eastern Avenue” means that length of the London-Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A12) in the London Borough of Redbridge known as Eastern Avenue,

“central reservation” means the provision made in Eastern Avenue for separating a part of the carriageway which is to be used by traffic proceeding in a westerly direction from a part of the carriageway which is to be used by traffic proceeding in an easterly direction.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the westbound carriageway of Eastern Avenue to make a U-turn through the gap in the central reservation which lies opposite Studley Drive so as to proceed eastwards in the eastbound carriageway.
