The Southern Water Authority (Brighton, Medway and North West Sussex) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978

Made - - - - - 15th December 1978

Coming into Operation 27th December 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Southern Water Authority (Brighton Medway and North West Sussex) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 27th December 1978.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“byelaws” means byelaws made under section 17 of the Water Act 1945;

“the Order of 1977” means the Southern Water Authority (Brighton, Medway and North West Sussex) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977(c).

3. The byelaws made by—

(a) the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the county borough of Brighton, acting by the council of that borough on 5th June 1964, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Order of 1977, remain in force until 31st December 1978;

(b) the Medway Water Board on 6th March 1967, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Order of 1977, remain in force until 31st December 1978; and

(c) the North West Sussex Water Board on 3rd May 1977, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Order of 1977, remain in force until 31st December 1978,

shall remain in force until 31st December 1980.
