The Welfare Food (Amendment No. 2) Order 1978

Made - - - - 18th December 1978
Laid before Parliament 22nd December 1978
Coming into Operation 15th January 1979

The Secretary of State for Social Services and the Secretary of State for Wales in exercise of powers conferred by sections 4 and 7 of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964^(a) and now vested in them^(b), acting with the Secretary of State for Scotland jointly in the exercise of those powers and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order as follows:—

Title, commencement and extent

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Welfare Food (Amendment No. 2) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 15th January 1979.

(2) This order shall not extend to Northern Ireland.

Interpretation

2. In this order “the principal order” means the Welfare Food Order 1977^(c) as amended by the Welfare Food (Amendment) Order 1977^(d), the Welfare Food (Amendment No. 2) Order 1977^(e) and the Welfare Food (Amendment) Order 1978^(f) and other words and expressions have the same meaning as in the principal order.

Amendment of the principal order

3. In Schedule 1 (Entitlement to welfare food other than welfare milk) to the principal order in column (3):—

(a) for “9p” there shall be substituted “10p”, and

(b) for “17p” in each place where it occurs there shall be substituted “24p”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Welfare Food Order 1977, as amended by the Welfare Food (Amendment) Order 1977, the Welfare Food (Amendment No. 2) Order 1977 and the Welfare Food (Amendment) Order 1978, by increasing the prices at which Children's Vitamin Drops and Vitamin Tablets for expectant and nursing mothers may be bought as follows:—

- (i) Children's Vitamin Drops: from 9p to 10p per bottle.
- (ii) Mother's Vitamin Tablets: from 17p to 24p per container.
