The Local Authorities (Allowances) (Scotland)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 45 and 50 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Title and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Authorities (Allowances) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 25th January 1979.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Increase in rates of financial loss allowance

3. In regulation 3(2) of the Local Authorities (Allowances) (Scotland) Regulations 1975(c) as amended(d) (which prescribes the rate of financial loss allowance) at sub-paragraph (a) for “£5.38” there shall be substituted “£6.20” and at sub-paragraphs (b) and (c) for the words “£10.75” where they occur respectively there shall be substituted “£12.40”.

4. The Local Authorities (Allowances) (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1977(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations prescribe revised maximum amounts which may be paid to members of any body to which Sections 45-50 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 as amended by Paragraph 46 of Schedule 6 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1975 (c. 30) apply by way of financial loss allowance for loss of earnings or additional expenses (other than travelling or subsistence incurred in the performance of their duties.
