Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 2(1) of the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fugitive Offenders (Designated Commonwealth Countries) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 24th January 1979.
- 2. The following countries are hereby designated for the purposes of section 1 of the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967:—

Commonwealth of Dominica

Solomon Islands

Tuvalu.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 2(1) of the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967 enables any country within the Commonwealth to be designated by Order in Council for the purposes of section 1 of the Act (so that the provisions of the Act relating to the return of offenders to independent Commonwealth countries and not those relating to United Kingdom dependencies will apply). This Order designates the Commonwealth of Dominica, the Solomon Islands and Tuvalu for those purposes.
