**The Trunk Road (A1) (Temporary Slip Road)
Order 1978**

Made - - - - - 20th December 1978

Coming into Operation 3rd January 1979

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b), and now vested in him(c), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Secretary of State for the Home Department, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (A1) (Temporary Slip Road) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 3rd January 1979.

2.—(1) In this Order “temporary southbound slip road” means the length of road which links the southbound carriageway of the M1 Motorway with the southbound carriageway of Watford Way (A1).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. No person shall, except at the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the temporary southbound slip road.
