# LAND DRAINAGE

# The Anglian Water Authority (Variation of the Longstanton and Swavesey Awards) Order 1978

Made - - - 28th December 1978
Coming into Operation 12th March 1979

Whereas the Anglian Water Authority prepared and submitted to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter called "the Minister") for confirmation a Scheme (hereinafter called "the Scheme") under section 25(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976(a);

And whereas the Minister has decided to confirm the Scheme, a copy of which is annexed hereto;

Now, therefore, the Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 25(4) and 109(6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976, and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This Order, which may be cited as the Anglian Water Authority (Variation of the Longstanton and Swavesey Awards) Order 1978, shall, unless subject to special parliamentary procedure, come into operation on the date of its confirmation by the Minister.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978(b) applies to this Order as it applies to subordinate legislation made after the commencement of that Act.
  - 3. The Scheme is hereby confirmed.
- 4. The expenses of the Minister in connection with the making and confirmation of this Order shall be borne by the Anglian Water Authority and shall be part of the administrative expenses of that Authority.

#### LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1976

#### ANGLIAN WATER AUTHORITY

#### SOUTH CAMBRIDGESHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

Whereas section 25 of the Land Drainage Act 1976 provides that where any Award made under any public or local Act contains any provision which in any manner affects or relates to the drainage of land in a water authority area then the water authority may submit to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter called "the Minister") for confirmation a Scheme for revoking, varying or amending that provision;

And whereas by the Awards particulars of which are set out in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter called "the Awards") provisions were made for the repair and maintenance work as therein specified to certain drains set out and described therein including in particular those drains (hereinafter called "the said drains") which are shown coloured red on the map sealed by the Anglian Water Authority (hereinafter called "the Water Authority") in relation to this Scheme:

And whereas the responsibility for the repair and maintenance of the said drains under the Awards has devolved upon the South Cambridgeshire District Council (hereinafter called "the Council");

And whereas the Water Authority has resolved to accept responsibility for the maintenance of the said drains and has applied to the Minister under section 9(5) of the Land Drainage Act 1976 for the variation of the main river map so as to treat the aforesaid drains as part of the Water Authority's main river:

Now therefore the Water Authority in pursuance of section 25(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976 submit the following Scheme to the Minister for confirmation.

#### SCHEME

On a day to be appointed by the Minister (hereinafter called "the appointed day") the provisions of the Awards shall be altered in the following respect that is to say:

The said drains shall be forever hereafter cleansed, scoured, repaired and maintained by the Water Authority subject to the payment to them by the Council of the sum of Twenty thousand pounds which sum shall be payable within one month of the appointed day and shall be accepted by the Water Authority as full commutation of all the liabilities of the Council under the Awards or otherwise in respect of the said drains: Provided that nothing herein shall operate to relieve the Council of any duty imposed by the said Awards in respect of Public Bridges.
