The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) (Amendment) Regulations 1978

Made - - - 1st March 1978

Laid before Parliament 3rd March 1978

Coming into Operation 31st March 1978

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 47(1), 50(1) and 51(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), as amended and extended by section 10 of the Road Traffic Act 1974(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of the said Act of 1972, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) (Amendment) Regulations 1978, and shall come into operation on 31st March 1978.
- 2. The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) Regulations 1976(c), as amended (d), shall be further amended in Regulations 3(1)(a) (Application of Regulations) and 14 (Prohibition of use of vehicles on roads) thereof by substituting for the words "1st April 1978" the words "1st August 1978".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) Regulations 1976, as amended by the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) (Amendment) Regulations 1977, by altering the date "1st April, 1978" in Regulations 3(1)(a) and 14 to "1st August 1978". The effect of the alteration is to postpone by four months the coming into operation of the scheme for the compulsory type approval of certain motor vehicles and their parts.
