3. This Order may be cited as the North of Ipswich-Norwich Trunk Road (A140 Trunking) Order 1978.

### SCHEDULE

#### HIGHWAY TO BECOME TRUNK ROAD

The highway to become trunk road is shown by striped hatching on the plan and is that length of the A140 Cromer to Ipswich Road which extends from its junction with the Felixstowe-Weedon Trunk Road A45 at Coddenham in the District of Mid-Suffolk northwards to the point where it meets the A47 Norwich Southern Ring Road in the County of Norfolk (a distance measured along the said road of approximately 34.15 miles).
