## WINDING-UP

**The Companies (Department of Trade) Fees (Amendment)  
Order 1978**

*Made* - - - - - 12th April 1978  
*Coming into Operation* - - - - - 9th May 1978

The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 365(3) of the Companies Act 1948(a) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b), hereby make, sanction and consent to the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Companies (Department of Trade) Fees (Amendment) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 9th May 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Schedule to Companies (Department of Trade) Fees Order 1975(d), as amended(e), shall have effect subject to the following further amendments:—

(a) In Fee No. 6 in the Schedule to that Order for the figure “£3.00” there shall be substituted the figure “£3.75”.

(b) For Fee No. 7 there shall be substituted the following fee:—

“7 At the due date for liquidators (including the Official Receiver when he is liquidator) sending accounts of their receipts and payments as liquidator to the Secretary of State under section 249 of the Companies Act 1948, a fee according to the following scale on the amount brought to credit, including the produce of calls on contributories, but after deducting (1) the amount spent out of the money received in carrying on the business of the company and (2) amounts paid by the Official Receiver or liquidator to secured creditors (other than debenture holders)—

(a) on the first £100,000 or fraction thereof per cent.	7.50
(b) on the next £400,000 or fraction thereof per cent.	6.50
(c) on the next £500,000 or fraction thereof per cent.	3.75
(d) on all further sums	per cent. 2.00”

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#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order substitutes for Fees No. 7 and 10(2)(iii) an *ad valorem* fee payable by every liquidator (including an Official Receiver when acting as such) on the submission to the Secretary of State of accounts of their receipts and payments under section 249 of the Companies Act 1948, and increases from £3.00 to £3.75 the fee payable for insertion in the *London Gazette* of notices in proceedings for the winding-up of companies.

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
