**BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES****The Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Scotland) Amendment  
Regulations 1978**

*Made* - - - - - 19th January 1978  
*Laid before Parliament* 27th January 1978  
*Coming into Operation* 20th February 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 14(2) and 51 of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with the Gaming Board for Great Britain, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 20th February 1978.

(2) These regulations shall extend to Scotland only.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if these regulations and the regulations revoked by these regulations were Acts of Parliament.

3. Regulation 5(1) of the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Scotland) Regulations 1970(c), as amended(d), shall be amended by substituting for the words “£1”, in both places where they occur, the words “£1.50”.

4. The Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1976(e) are hereby revoked.

These Regulations increase the maximum charges which may be made for admission to gaming on bingo club premises in Scotland from £1 to £1.50 and revoke the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1976.
