**The Severn-Trent Water Authority (North West Worcestershire and Leicester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978**

*Made* - - - - - 26th June 1978  
*Coming into Operation* 1st July 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Severn-Trent Water Authority (North West Worcestershire and Leicester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1978.

2. The byelaws made on 21st August 1964 by the North West Worcestershire Water Board under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Severn-Trent Water Authority (North West Worcestershire) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976(c), remain in force until 20th August 1978, shall remain in force until 20th August 1980.

3. The byelaws made on 1st August 1968 by the lord mayor, aldermen and citizens of the city of Leicester acting by the council under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, but for this order, cease to have effect on 31st July 1978, shall remain in force until 31st July 1980.
