Special Roads

The Motorways Traffic (Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East) (A6127(M)) (Speed Limit) Regulations 1978

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 107(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motorways Traffic (Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East) (A6127(M)) (Speed Limit) Regulations 1978, and shall come into operation on 27th July 1978.

2.—(1) In these Regulations “the Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East and its associated slip roads and connecting roads” means the special roads provided in pursuance of the Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East Scheme 1966 (a scheme under section 11 of the Highways Act 1959(c) which was confirmed by the Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East Scheme 1966 Confirmation Instrument 1969(d)). A plan marked “The Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East” (based upon the plan referred to in the said Scheme) is deposited at the Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne 1 and shows by reference letters “A” to “H” and “J” to “U” (inclusive) and by heavy black lines or by broken black lines the routes of these special roads.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on any part of the Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East and its associated slip roads and connecting roads.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations impose a 50 m.p.h. speed limit on all the special roads which constitute the Newcastle upon Tyne Central Motorway East. Copies of the plan which is referred to in Regulation 2 and which shows the routes of these special roads are deposited at:—Tyne and Wear County Council, Sandyford House, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE2 1ED; the office of the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation), Northern Regional Office, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 4TX, and The Department of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London, SE1 0TE, where they may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours on Mondays to Fridays (other than public holidays) in any week.
