The Minister of Transport makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 7 and 286 of the Highways Act 1959(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The Newport-Monmouth-Ross-on-Wye-Worcester Trunk Road (Massington Railway Bridge and Ledbury Reservoir Diversions) Order 1961(c) is hereby revoked.

2. This Order shall come into operation on 21st September 1979 and may be cited as the Newport-Monmouth-Ross-on-Wye-Worcester Trunk Road (Massington Railway Bridge and Ledbury Reservoir Diversions) (Revocation) Order 1979.
