The Thames Water Authority (Bibury) Order 1979

Made - - - - 22nd August 1979

Coming into Operation 3rd September 1979

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Thames Water Authority (Bibury) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 3rd September 1979. Citation and commencement.

(2) The Thames Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1977 and this order may be cited together as the Thames Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1979.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“the Authority” means the Thames Water Authority;

“the borehole” means the borehole 6 inches in diameter constructed on and under the land described in Schedule 1 to this order;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the water undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

Interpretation.

3. The Authority may on or under the land described in Schedule 1 to this order and owned by it continue and maintain the borehole and (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) may construct and maintain all such additional wells, boreholes, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting, improving or maintaining the supply of water obtainable by means of the borehole. Authorisation of works.

4. The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking. Works to form part of the undertaking.

5. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order. Application of provisions of Third Schedule.

SCHEDULE 1

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Land in the Parish of Bibury in the District of Cotswold in the County of Gloucestershire comprising 10.5 sq. metres (113 sq. ft.) or thereabouts and being part of the enclosure numbered 9744 on the 1/2500 ordnance survey National Grid Plan SP 1007-1107 (1976 Edition).

PROVISIONS OF THE THIRD SCHEDULE APPLIED

Section 4 (General power to construct subsidiary works) Section 94 (Copies of special Act to be kept by undertakers in their office, and deposited with certain officers)	The words "and to any other provisions of the special Act limiting the powers of the undertakers to abstract water" shall be omitted, and for the words "any land for the time being held by them in connection with their water undertaking" there shall be substituted the words "any of the land described in the special Act".
