**WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Cambridge Water Order 1979**

*Made* - - - - *24th August 1979*

*Coming into Operation* *5th September 1979*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Cambridge Water Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 5th September 1979. Citation and commencement.

(2) The Cambridge Water Acts and Orders 1853 to 1978 and this order may be cited together as the Cambridge Water Acts and Orders 1853 to 1979.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

“the Company” means the Cambridge Water Company;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Company as for the time being authorised by any enactment. Interpretation.

3. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order. Application of certain provisions of Third Schedule.

4.—(1) The Company may—

(a) continue and maintain the existing boreholes constructed on or under the land described in Schedule 2 to this order and construct or continue and maintain on or under such land a pumping station (to be called “the Morden Grange Pumping Station”) and pumping plant for the purpose of abstracting water from the said boreholes; Construction and maintenance of works.

(b) construct and maintain on or under the lands described in the said Schedule 2 (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) all such additional boreholes, wells, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting, improving or maintaining the supply of water obtainable by means of the said boreholes.

(2) The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

## SCHEDULE 1

### PROVISIONS OF THE THIRD SCHEDULE APPLIED

Section 4 (General power to construct subsidiary works)	The words "and to any other provisions of the special Act limiting the powers of the undertakers to abstract water" shall be omitted; and for the words "any land for the time being held by them in connection with their water undertaking" there shall be substituted the words "the lands described in Schedule 2 to the special Act".
Section 5 (Power of undertakers to lay or erect telephone wires &c.)	—
Section 6 (Penalty for obstructing construction of works)	—
Part IV (Minerals Underlying Waterworks)	—
