**The Stanswood Bay Oyster Fishery
(Extension of Period) Order 1979**

Made - - - - 7th September 1979

Laid before Parliament 14th September 1979

Coming into Operation 1st June 1980

Whereas the Stanswood Bay Oyster Fishery Order 1973(a) (hereinafter called "the principal order"), will, unless extended, cease to be in operation upon the expiration of 7 years from the 2nd June 1973:

And whereas it is expedient that the provisions of the principal order should continue to apply to the fishery therein described after the expiration of the said period:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, no objections which he considers to be relevant having been received to a draft order published in accordance with Schedule 1 to the Sea Fisheries (Shellfish) Act 1967(b) in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, with the consent of the Crown Estate Commissioners, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Stanswood Bay Oyster Fishery (Extension of Period) Order 1979, and shall come into operation on 1st June 1980.

Variation of Principal Order

2. Subject to the provisions of section 5 of the Sea Fisheries (Shellfish) Act 1967 the principal order shall continue in operation for a period of 15 years from the 1st June 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order continues the Stanswood Bay Oyster Fishery Order 1973 in operation for a further 15 years after the day (1st June 1980) at the end of which it would otherwise have ceased to operate.
