**The Social Security (Claims and Payments)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1979**

Made - - - - 26th September 1979

Laid before Parliament 4th October 1979

Coming into Operation 25th October 1979

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 81 of the Social Security Act 1975 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after reference to the National Insurance Advisory Committee, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1979, amend the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations 1979 (b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”) and shall come into operation on 25th October 1979.

Amendment of regulation 16 of the principal regulations

2. In paragraph (5) of regulation 16 of the principal regulations (benefits payable on Tuesdays) the words “guardian’s allowance” are deleted and after that paragraph there is inserted the following new paragraph:—

“(5A) Weekly sums on account of guardian’s allowance shall be payable on Tuesdays or, if the Secretary of State so arranges in respect of any particular case or class of case, on Mondays.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations, which amend the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations 1979, enable the Secretary of State to arrange for weekly payments of guardian's allowance to be made on Mondays instead of Tuesdays.

The Report of the National Insurance Advisory Committee dated 5th September 1979 on the draft of these Regulations referred to them is contained in Command Paper (Cmnd. 7680) published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office.
