# The Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road (Woolsbridge Road to Ashley Cross Roundabout) (Detrunking) Order 1979

The Minister of Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The length of trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which this Order comes into operation.

2. In this Order:-

"the deposited plan" means the plan numbered HA 7/2—SW125 marked "The Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road (Woolsbridge Road to Ashley Cross Roundabout) (Detrunking) Order 1979" signed by authority of the Minister and deposited at the Department of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 0TE, where it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours.

3. In this Order all measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway.

4. This Order shall come into operation on 12th November 1979 and may be cited as the Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road (Woolsbridge Road to Ashley Cross Roundabout) (Detrunking) Order 1979.

#### LENGTH OF TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

That length of the service road which forms part of the Folkestone-Honiton Trunk Road (A31) in the Parish of St. Leonards and St. Ives in the District of Wimborne in the County of Dorset which extends from the eastern side of its junction with Woolsbridge Road to a point 125 metres north-east of the eastern side of its junction with Sandy Lane (a distance measured along the said length of road of 1,525 metres).
