HOVERCRAFT

The Hovercraft (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1979

Made - - - - 10th October 1979

Coming into Operation 1st December 1979

The Secretary of State, with the approval of the Treasury and in exercise of his powers under Article 35 of the Hovercraft (General) Order 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. The Regulations may be cited as the Hovercraft (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1979.

2. The Schedule to the Hovercraft (Fees) Regulations 1978(b) shall be amended as follows:—

In paragraph 10:

(1) In subparagraph (1) for subparagraphs (a) to (d) there shall be substituted:

“(a) does not exceed 5 tonnes	£
(b) exceeds 5 tonnes but does not exceed 50 tonnes	80
(c) exceeds 50 tonnes but does not exceed 100 tonnes	220
(d) exceeds 100 tonnes	430
		700”

(2) In subparagraph (3) for “£10” there shall be substituted “£40”.
