## CONTINENTAL SHELF

**The Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order  
1979**

Made - - - - 14th November 1979

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 14th day of November 1979

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by the Continental Shelf (Designation of Areas) Order 1964(a), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1965(b), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1968(c), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1971(d), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1974(e), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1976(f), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1977(g), the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1978(h), and the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) (No. 2) Order 1978(i), certain areas outside the territorial waters of the United Kingdom are designated as areas within the rights of the United Kingdom with respect to the sea bed and subsoil and their natural resources may be exercised:

And whereas it is expedient that further such areas should be so designated:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 1(7) of the Continental Shelf Act 1964(j) and all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1979.

(2) This Order and the Orders recited in the preamble to this Order may be cited together as the Continental Shelf (Designation of Areas) Orders 1964 to 1979.

2. The areas defined in the Schedule to this Order are hereby designated as areas within which the rights of the United Kingdom outside territorial waters with respect to the sea bed and subsoil and their natural resources are exercisable.

## SCHEDULE

The following are the areas to which Article 2 of this Order applies:

(1) The area bounded by a line joining the following co-ordinates on European Datum:

- (1) 61° 45' 00" N; 2° 00' 00" W;
- (2) 61° 45' 00" N; 3° 00' 00" W;

and the co-ordinates numbered (2) and (3) in the Schedule to the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1978 and the co-ordinates numbered (1) in this Schedule.

(2) The area bounded:

(a) on the East and North by a line joining the following co-ordinates on European Datum:

- (21) 62° 30' 00" N; 1° 00' 00" W;
- (22) 62° 30' 00" N; 2° 00' 00" W;

and the co-ordinates numbered (43), (44) and (45) in the Schedule to the Continental Shelf (Designation of Additional Areas) Order 1971 and the co-ordinates numbered (3) in this Schedule.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order designates further areas of the Continental Shelf in the northern North Sea as areas in which the rights of the United Kingdom with respect to the sea bed and subsoil and their natural resources may be exercised.
