The York Water Order 1979

Made - - - - - 26th November 1979

Coming into Operation 4th December 1979

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 23 and 33 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the York Water Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 4th December 1979. Citation and commencement.

(2) The York Water Acts and Orders 1846 to 1975 and this order may be cited together as the York Water Acts and Orders 1846 to 1979.

2. In this order unless the context otherwise requires “the Company” means the York Waterworks Company. Interpretation.

3. Section 4(1) of the York Water Order 1973(c), as amended by section 2 of the York Water Order 1975(d), shall have effect as if— Additional borrowing powers.

(a) in paragraph (i) of the proviso, after “(i)” there were inserted the word “twice”; and

(b) in paragraph (ii) thereof, for the word “five” there were substituted the word “ten”.

4. For the purpose of constituting a meeting of the Company, whether ordinary or extraordinary, the prescribed quorum referred to in section 72 of the Companies Clauses Consolidation Act 1845(e), as incorporated with the enactments of the Company, shall be five holders of stock of the Company. Quorum for meetings of the Company.

5. As from the coming into operation of this order the following section shall be substituted for section 77 of the York Waterworks Act 1932(f):— Number of directors.

“Number of directors. 77. The number of directors shall be such as the Company may from time to time determine but shall not be more than eleven or less than five.”

6. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (which relate to the deposit of the special Act), shall apply to the undertaking of the Company and are hereby incorporated with this order.
