## OIL POLLUTION

**The Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment) Regulations 1979**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 11(3)(a) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 2 January 1980.

2. In regulation 5 (fee for certificates) of the Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) Regulations 1977(b) for “£12” there shall be substituted “£19”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Oil Pollution (Compulsory Insurance) Regulations 1977 by increasing the fee to be paid on application for a certificate of compulsory insurance from £12 to £19.
