The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 67 and 68(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Industrial Development Certificates) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1980.

2. The Town and Country Planning (Industrial Development Certificates) Regulations 1979(b) are hereby amended in Schedule 1 by the insertion of "Corby", in the appropriate position according to alphabetical order, under the heading "East Midlands Region".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Town and Country Planning (Industrial Development Certificates) Regulations 1979 to the effect that an industrial development certificate shall no longer be required for the erection of any industrial building in the employment office area of Corby or for a change of use as a result of which premises in that area which are not an industrial building will become an industrial building.
