The Mink (Keeping) (Amendment) Regulations 1979

Made - - - - - 11th December 1979

Coming into Operation 1st January 1980

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2(c) of the Destructive Imported Animals Act 1932(a), as applied in relation to mink by the Mink (Keeping) Order 1977(b) and now vested in them(c), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Mink (Keeping) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1980.

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. The Mink (Keeping) Regulations 1975(d), shall be amended by substituting in regulation 5(3) for the figures “£28.50” the figures “£35”.
