**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 5)
Order 1979***Made - - - - 12th December 1979**Coming into Operation 13th December 1979*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 5) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 13th December 1979.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978(c) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) Article 2(vii) (which prohibits the export of goods of any description to any destination in Southern Rhodesia) shall be deleted;
- (b) Article 3(2) shall be deleted;
- (c) in Schedule 2 after “South Africa, Republic of” there shall be inserted “Southern Rhodesia”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the provisions of the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1978 which prohibited the export of all goods to any destination in Southern Rhodesia. In future the export of goods to Southern Rhodesia will be governed by the same rules as apply to any other country included in Schedule 2 to the 1978 Order to which Southern Rhodesia has been added.
