## The National Savings Stock Register (Amendment)

## Regulations 1979

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>7th December 1979</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>14th December 1979</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>4th January 1980</i>

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 3 of the National Debt Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, in conjunction, so far as the Regulations relate to the National Debt Commissioners, with those Commissioners, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Savings Stock Register (Amendment) Regulations 1979, and shall come into operation on 4th January 1980.

2. The National Savings Stock Register Regulations 1976(b) shall be amended in Regulation 7(2) as follows—

(a) by substituting a semicolon for the full stop at the end of sub-paragraph (i);

(b) by adding the following sub-paragraph after sub-paragraph (i):—

“(j) by the Accountant General of the Supreme Court.”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations, which amend the National Savings Stock Register Regulations 1976, exempt the Accountant General of the Supreme Court from the £5,000 limit on the amount of stock of any one description which may be purchased by any one person on any one day.
