ROAD TRAFFIC

**The Trunk Road (North Circular Road, Brent)
(Prescribed Routes) Order 1979**

Made - - - - - *19th December 1979*
Coming into Operation *28th December 1979*

The Minister of Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Secretary of State for the Home Department, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (North Circular Road, Brent) (Prescribed Routes) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 28th December 1979.

2. In this Order:—

“North Circular Road” means the length of the London North Circular Trunk Road (A406) in the London Borough of Brent known as North Circular Road.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave North Circular Road at its junctions with Wrights Place or Garden Way.

4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden.
