The Savings Banks (Registrar's Fees) (Amendment) Warrant 1979

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - - 31st December 1979

Coming into Operation 1st January 1980

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 88 of the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1969(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby direct as follows:—

1. This Warrant may be cited as the Savings Banks (Registrar's Fees) (Amendment) Warrant 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1980.

2. The Savings Banks (Registrar's Fees) Warrant 1976(b) shall be amended in article 3 thereof as follows:—

- for "£162·00" there shall be substituted "£486·00";
- for "£108·00" there shall be substituted "£324·00"; and
- for "£54·00" there shall be substituted "£162·00".
