**The Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment)
Regulations 1979**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4(3) of the Immigration Act 1971(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1979.

2. In Regulation 10(3) of the Immigration (Registration with Police) Regulations 1972(b) (which relates to the fees to be paid for the issue of registration certificates) for the words “£8” and “£2” there shall be substituted the words “£10” and “£3” respectively.
