**The Cereals Marketing Act 1965 (Amendment)
Regulations 1979**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	10th January 1979
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	19th January 1979
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	9th February 1979

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 7 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with such organisations as appear to them appropriate as representing any interests concerned, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Cereals Marketing Act 1965 (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 9th February 1979.

Amendment of the Cereals Marketing Act 1965

2. The Cereals Marketing Act 1965(b) shall be amended by substituting in sections 13(4), 15(1) and 16(6)(a) for the word "acreage" where it appears the word "area".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations, which come into operation on 9th February 1979, further amend the Cereals Marketing Act 1965, as amended, by substituting references to "area" for references to "acreage" in sections 13(4), 15(1) and 16(6)(a) of that Act, which provide for the specification of a rate of levy and its imposition.

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
