The Revocation of Instrument of Management (St. Vincent's Home) Order 1979

Whereas the Trustees of St. Vincent's Home, Castle Road, Tankerton, have given not less than 2 years' notice in writing to the Secretary of State and to the London Borough of Bexley of their intention to cease to provide the assisted community home known as St. Vincent's Home, as from 1st January 1980;

And whereas the body of managers of the aforesaid home have given notice in writing to the Secretary of State that they are unwilling to continue as managers of the aforesaid home until the date specified in the first mentioned notice;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of his powers under section 47(4) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Revocation of Instrument of Management (St. Vincent's Home) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 11th April 1979.

(2) In this order, unless the context otherwise requires,

"the Act" means the Children and Young Persons Act 1969;

"the home" means the voluntary home known as St. Vincent's Home, Castle Road, Tankerton;

"the Instrument of Management" means St. Vincent's Home, Tankerton, Instrument of Management Order 1973;

"specified date" means 11th April 1979.

(3) The date specified for the purpose of section 47(4)(b) of the Act is 13th April 1979.

Revocation of Instrument of Management

2. The Instrument of Management is revoked as from the specified date.

Conduct of the Home

3. The London Borough of Bexley shall conduct the home until 13th April 1979 as if it were a community home provided by the aforesaid Borough.

This order revokes the Instrument of Management for St. Vincent's Home, Tankerton as from 11th April 1979 and makes provision for the London Borough of Bexley to run the home as if it were a community home provided by the Borough from that date until 13th April 1979.
