The Rate Support Grants (Adjustment of Needs Element) (Amendment) Regulations 1979

Made - - - 21st March 1979
Laid before Parliament 21st March 1979
Coming into Operation 1st April 1979

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 10(3) of the Local Government Act 1974(a) and paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 thereto after consulting with such associations of local authorities as appeared to her to be concerned in accordance with section 10(5) of the said Act, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Rate Support Grants (Adjustment of Needs Element) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1979.
- (2) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Rate Support Grants (Adjustment of Needs Element) Regulations 1976(b).
- 2. In regulation 2 of the principal regulations (expenditure to which those regulations apply) for the figures "£75,000" and "£30,000" there shall be substituted the figures "£100,000" and "£40,000" respectively.
- 3. Nothing in regulation 2 above shall affect the principal regulations in their application to a financial year (within the meaning thereof) beginning before 1st April 1979.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Rate Support Grants (Adjustment of Needs Element) Regulations 1976 and, in respect of each establishment of further education (including those recognised by the Secretary of State as polytechnics), increase the amounts of capital expenditure from revenue in a financial year to which those regulations apply.
