PROTECTION OF WRECKS

The Protection of Wrecks (Revocation) Order 1979

Made - - - 4th January 1979

Laid before Parliament 8th January 1979

Coming into Operation 31st January 1979

The Secretary of State, being of opinion that there is no longer any wreck which requires protection under the Protection of Wrecks Act 1973(a) in the area specified in Article 3 of the Protection of Wrecks (Designation No. 6) Order 1974(b) ("the said Order"), in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3(2)(a) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Protection of Wrecks (Revocation) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 31st January 1979.
 - 2. The said Order is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the Protection of Wrecks (Designation No. 6) Order 1974 which designated as a restricted area an area in the Sound of Mull round the site of the vessel HMS "Dartmouth" because the Secretary of State no longer considers that the wreck requires protection under the Protection of Wrecks Act 1973 (c. 33).
