**The Consumer Credit (Notice of Variation of Agreements)
(Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1979**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 82(1), 182(2) and 189(1) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Consumer Credit (Notice of Variation of Agreements) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 18th June 1979.

2. The Consumer Credit (Notice of Variation of Agreements) Regulations 1977(b) are hereby further amended, in paragraph (2)(b) of regulation 4 (which was inserted by the Consumer Credit (Notice of Variation of Agreements) (Amendment) Regulations 1979(c)), by the substitution for the word “debtor” of the word “hirer”.
