The Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants) Order 1979

Made	28th June 1979
Laid before the House of Commons	6th July 1979
Coming into Operation	27th July 1979

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16(1) and (5) of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963(a), and now vested in them(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby order as follows:-

Citation, extent, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This order, which may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants) Order 1979, shall apply to Great Britain and shall come into operation on 27th July 1979.
- (2) In this order "the Order of 1978" means the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978(c).

Fees for the testing of disinfectants

2. There shall be payable to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in respect of the testing, in pursuance of Article 7(1) of the Order of 1978, of any disinfectant submitted for the purpose of having such disinfectant listed as approved in the Schedule to that order the fees set out in the Schedule to this order.

Revocation

3. The Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants) Order 1978(d) is hereby revoked.
