**The Burgh Police (Scotland) Act 1892 (Application of Provisions)  
(Eastwood District Council) Order 1979**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	28th June 1979
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	12th July 1979
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	3rd August 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 229(3) and 233(3) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Burgh Police (Scotland) Act 1892 (Application of Provisions) (Eastwood District Council) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 3rd August 1979.

*Interpretation*

2. In this order:—

“the Act” means the Burgh Police (Scotland) Act 1892(b)

“the district” means the area of Eastwood District

“the district court” means the District Court for the area of Eastwood District.

*Application of provisions of the Act*

3.—(1) The following provisions of the Act shall be extended to apply throughout the district—

(i) section 270 (Hackney carriages to be licensed);

(ii) section 271 and Schedule V (Regulations for hackney carriages);

(iii) section 454 in its application to Schedule V and sections 465, 484, 491, 499, 500, 503, 511 and 512, all as read with section 3 of the District Courts (Scotland) Act 1975(c).

(2) The said provisions in their application as extended at paragraph (1) above shall have effect subject to the modifications thereof which are set out in the Schedule to this order.

## SCHEDULE

Article 3(2)

PROVISION	MODIFICATION
Section 270 .. ..	For the words "five miles from the principal post office of the burgh" there shall be substituted the words "the area of Eastwood District", and for the words "within the burgh" there shall be substituted the words "within the said district".
Schedule V .. ..	For the words "prescribed distance" wherever they occur, except where they secondly occur at paragraphs (9) and (23), there shall be substituted the words "the area of Eastwood District", and at paragraphs (9) and (23) for the words "not exceeding such prescribed distance" there shall be substituted the words "not being beyond the boundary of Eastwood District".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order applies those provisions of the Burgh Police (Scotland) Act 1892 which relate to the licensing and control of hackney carriages to the whole of the area of Eastwood District.
