**The Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1978
(Continuance) Order 1979***Laid before Parliament in draft**Made - - - 11th July 1979**Coming into Operation 25th July 1979*

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 33(3)(a) of the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1978(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1978 (Continuance) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 25th July 1979.

2. In this Order “the temporary provisions of the Act of 1978” means all the provisions of the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1978, except sections 5 and 28 to 36, Part III of Schedule 4, Schedules 5 and 6 and, so far as they relate to offences which are scheduled offences by virtue of the said Part III, sections 2, 6 and 7.

3. The temporary provisions of the Act of 1978 shall continue in force for a period of six months beginning with 25th July 1979.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
