CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Harford and Ivybridge (Areas) Order 1979

Made - - - - - 31st January 1979
Coming into Operation—
for the purposes described in article 2
for all other purposes - - 1st April 1979

Whereas the District Council of South Hams, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals for the transfer of part of the Parish of Harford in the said district to the Parish of Ivybridge in that district; And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Harford and Ivybridge (Areas) Order 1979.
- 2. 14th February 1979 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1979.

Changes in areas

- 3.—(1) That part of the Parish of Harford which is shown coloured red on the map shall be transferred to the Parish of Ivybridge and shall form part of the Ivybridge ward of the District of South Hams.
- (2) In this article "the map" means the map printed for Her Majesty's Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey as "Map referred to in the Harford and Ivybridge (Areas) Order 1979".



This Order transfers part of the Parish of Harford in the District of South Hams to the Parish of Ivybridge in that district. The transfer will add approximately 23 hectares, 470 population and £40,520 rateable value to the Parish of Ivybridge.
