Coming into Operation 3rd September 1979

The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 51 of the Matrimonial Causes Act 1973(a) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b), hereby make and concur in the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes Fees (Amendment) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 3rd September 1979.

2. The Matrimonial Causes Fees Order 1975(c), shall be further amended as follows:—

In Schedule 1, for the figures “£20.00” in Fee No. 2, there shall be substituted the figures “£25.00”.
