The Supplementary Benefits (Determination of Requirements) Regulations 1979

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - 3rd August 1979

Coming into Operation 12th November 1979

Whereas a draft of the following regulations was laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Social Services, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) and (3) of the Supplementary Benefits Act 1976(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Supplementary Benefits (Determination of Requirements) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 12th November 1979.

Amendment of provisions for calculating requirements

- 2.—(1) Part II (calculation of requirements) of Schedule 1 to the Supplementary Benefits Act 1976 (provisions for determining right to and amount of supplementary benefits) shall be varied in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation.
- (2) For paragraph 7 (normal requirements) and paragraph 8 (blind persons) there shall be substituted the following paragraphs—

"Normal requirements

7. Requirements of persons, other than blind persons—

(a) husband and wife or other persons falling within paragraph 3(1) of this Schedule ... A ... 29.70

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations vary the provisions of Part II (calculation of requirements) of Schedule 1 (determination of right to and amount of supplementary benefits) to the Supplementary Benefits Act 1976. Regulation 2 increases certain weekly amounts allowed for requirements; paragraph (2) relates to normal and blind persons' requirements; paragraph (3) relates to the attendance requirements of severely disabled persons and paragraph (4) to the rent addition for non-householders.
