BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES
The Gaming (Small Charges) (Amendment) Order 1980

Made - - - - - 31st July 1980

Laid before Parliament 7th August 1980

Coming into Operation 1st December 1980

In pursuance of sections 40(2) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming (Small Charges) (Amendment) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1980.

(2) This Order does not extend to Scotland.

2. Article 3(a) of the Gaming (Small Charges) Order 1975(b) shall be amended by substituting for the words “the sum of £3” the words “the sum of £6”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases from £3 to £6 the maximum daily charge which may be made in clubs and miners' welfare institutes in respect of a person taking part in gaming when the only games played are bridge and whist.
