# The Thames Water Authority (Langley Vale) Order 1980

Made -

1st February 1980

Coming into Operation

11th February 1980

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Thames Water Authority Citation (Langley Vale) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 11th February and com-1980.

- (2) The Thames Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1979 and this order may be cited together as the Thames Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1980.
  - 2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

"the Authority" means the Thames Water Authority;

"the borehole" means the borehole 24 inches in diameter constructed on and under the land described in Schedule 1 to this order:

"the Third Schedule" means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945:

"the undertaking" means the water undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3.—The Authority may, when they have obtained sufficient rights or Authorisainterest in the land described in Schedule 1 to this order, continue and tion of maintain the borehole and (in addition to the works authorised by works. section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) may construct and maintain on the said land all such additional wells, boreholes, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting, improving or maintaining the supply of water obtainable by means of the said borehole.

4. The borehole and any other works constructed in pursuance of this Works to form order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

5. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule Application which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this order shall, subject of provisions to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the underSchedule. taking and are hereby incorporated with this order.

### SCHEDULE 1

#### DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Land in the Parish of Epsom in the Borough of Epsom and Ewell in the County of Surrey comprising 240 square metres or thereabouts and being part of the enclosure numbered 5654 on the 1/2500 Ordnance Survey plans of Surrey Sheet TQ 2057 Edition of 1954.
