The Poisons (Amendment) Rules 1980

Made - - - - - 1st February 1980

Laid before Parliament 12th February 1980

Coming into Operation 17th March 1980

In pursuance of section 7 of the Poisons Act 1972(a) and on the recommendation of the Poisons Board, I hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Poisons (Amendment) Rules 1980 and shall come into operation on 17th March 1980.
2. The Poisons Rules 1978(b) shall be amended by the omission,
 - (a) in Group II of Schedule 3, of the item beginning with the word "Diamines"; and
 - (b) in Schedule 6, of paragraph 1.
